

SAFEGUARD MARINE SURVEYING LLC

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Marine Survey Work Order

The following statement concerning the procedures in the inspection of the subject vessel is for your information and benefit. Survey results will be transmitted only to the person or persons authorizing this survey and limited to their use, accordingly, others are not to use this report and not to rely upon the contents of this report without payment to Safeguard Marine Surveying LLC of an additional agreed fee based on reevaluation of same factors.

The survey process will include a non-destructive survey, which includes an inspection of all parts of the vessel where accessible, without removal of paneling, fittings or opening up to expose parts ordinarily concealed, and will also include condition and safety of all accessible parts and equipment, to determine the fair market value and replacement cost of the vessel. A surveyor's findings are limited to his or her ability to visually inspect portions of the vessel. Defects may be hidden from the surveyor's view by bulkheads, decks, upholstery, bottom paint, etc. Only accessible areas will be inspected, and it is understood that Safeguard Marine Surveying LLC and this surveyor assume no responsibility for any defects not found in non-accessible areas and is not responsible for conditions subsequently arising. We will make every attempt to determine the condition and value of the subject vessel within these reasonable limitations. Recommendations will include what must be done to insure safety and whether the boat is sound for its intended service. (Intended service is what the original designer and/or manufacturers' concept of capabilities and limitations for a specific design.)

The hull survey consists only of visual examination of the external surfaces of the hull structures, and neither includes nor implies any certification that the materials and construction methods utilized meet any known standards; that the survey is intended only to locate any such defects that may become apparent to visual inspection only. The surveyor is not aware of the nature of the hull material and cannot predict how it will perform over time.

Safeguard Marine Surveying LLC will perform a survey, not an analysis, and therefore will not express or imply warrant, or guarantee the condition, value of the vessel or the cost of any repairs to the vessel. We cannot be responsibly charged for any error omission or misstatement. Safeguard Marine Surveying LLC shall have no liability for personal injuries damages, no liability for consequential damages, no liability for property loss damages, and no liability for punitive damages, all of which shall be deemed to have been knowingly waived upon signature below and/or use of the report; further, in no event shall the legal liability of Safeguard Marine Surveying LLC or this surveyor ever exceed the fee paid by the requesting party for issuance of this report, regardless of the number of claims or suits and regardless of whether under theory of tort, contract, warranty, products, outrage or otherwise.

We urge that all gasoline and diesel engines be surveyed by a qualified Engine Surveyor to determine the condition of the engines, gears and the pumps, heat exchangers, coolers, etc. and is the responsibility of persons other than Safeguard Marine Surveying LLC and this surveyor.

An Engine Sea Trial Check is an additional tool to determine condition of vessel. It is in no way intended as an engine survey or intended to replace an engine survey but only to verify RPMs, temperatures and voltages.

It is recommended that a sea trial be performed and that the vessel be hauled out for dry dock inspection of the wetted surface area of the hull and underwater machinery.

Electronic equipment and accessories must be made accessible to the surveyor for inclusion in the survey. Electronics are powered up only.

All vessel documentation must be made available to the surveyor at time of survey.

Rigging on sailboats above eye level (aloft) and sails are the responsibility of persons other than Safeguard Marine Surveying LLC and this surveyor.

The report constitutes a description of the vessel at the time of survey.

This is also an authorization for surveyor and any other employee of Safeguard Marine Surveying LLC to board vessel named/listed below for the purpose of surveying vessel.
